Helping To Bring HOPE To Tallahassee's Homeless Community

The Tallahassee Coalition for the Homeless' vision of a comprehensive human services center called the Housing Opportunities and Personal Empowerment (HOPE) community is now becoming a reality.

Sperry & Associates crews are currently working on the HOPE community's family housing, food service and men's housing buildings. The project, located near the corner of Pensacola Street and Appleyard Drive, will eventually expand into a nine building campus – delivering a wide range of services to the homeless community.

Sperry & Associates, working with Hicks/Nation Architects was chosen to handle the design and construction services for the entire project. The HOPE community was designed to have a residential, rather than institutional feel.

The design challenge has been to keep costs down while providing low maintenance, highly durable facilities. An additional challenge has been to plan the HOPE community in stages that can be executed as funding becomes available.
